Hillingdon Street Angels are Recruiting - Street Angels provide support to those out on the streets of Uxbridge Town Centre on a Friday and Saturday night between the hours of 10pm and 4am - though often it is an earlier finish and you only commit to one evening a month. You go out as part of a team, which includes at least one man and one woman, with a designated team leader. Taxis home are provided if necessary. The work is voluntary, but many have found it rewarding, and a practical way to share the love of Jesus in a needy sector of our community. The role involves generally 'being there for people' - caring, listening, helping to break the tension if a difficult situation is developing - often giving out sweet lollipops as a distraction. Volunteers must be over 18, committed Christians, and have ideally been going to a local church for over a year, and have a compassionate heart to share the love of God in a gentle, non-threatening way.
