Belonging to St Giles' – Say 'I belong' by joining the Electoral Roll! You need to be baptised and be over 16 years old. If you live outside Ickenham you also need to have been attending regularly for at least six months. **In 2019 the current electoral roll becomes redundant – this occurs every 6 years when a completely new roll is prepared and we all have to re-apply.**

Application packs are now available and include GDPR data consent forms and information to enable us to meet our obligations under the new GDPR Regulations. The deadline for returning Electoral Roll forms is Sunday 7 April. **If you have not already picked up your pack please make sure you do so before leaving church today.**

Ash Wednesday 6 March – please note that services for Ash Wednesday will take place at 9.30am (Book of Common Prayer) and 8pm (Common Worship). Both services will offer optional ashing. (No 10am Thursday Communion service on 7 March.)

Sunday Lunch 24 March 1pm - Tickets (£15) on sale today and for the next two weeks for a 3 course lunch (to include wine and soft drinks) Please choose your starter (homemade) and main (roast beef with all the trimmings or a chicken dish) when buying your ticket. Tickets can also be bought from the church office. Numbers are strictly limited so please book your place asap.
