There are additional printed guidance sheets in the box which should not be removed but are available for consultation. **PLEASE NOTE: DO NOT USE** when the patient is conscious or is breathing or has a detectable pulse or other signs of circulation. Pediatric Electrodes are available for children under 8 years of age.
