One possible source of funding is the Heritage Lottery Fund. They require evidence of Community Engagement, and the Ickenham Festival Week offers us an ideal opportunity to show this. Last year we managed to open the church for three evenings with activities and had a lot of support from the Local Community. Any ideas, and offers of help, appreciated. *Linda*.
