Changes to our CYCLE of PRAYER - "Pray continually"

1 Thessalonians 5:17. From October, we will be changing the way we manage some of our public Cycle of Prayer. As the people of God in Ickenham, I believe it is our privilege and our responsibility to pray for others. One of the ways we do this is through the Cycle of Prayer we pray during our services. In this, we pray for our village street by street, we pray for those we know and love who are sick, we remember the friends and family of those who have died and we hold in prayer the families of those who are remembering a loved one's anniversary of death. As well as this we pray for the charities the PCC have chosen to support. In order to keep this cycle moving and responsive, we are changing the way we pray for our roads and the sick.

Road: We want to be able to pray for every road in Ickenham at least once a year. This will mean that with effect from early 2025 we will be praying for two or three roads each week.

Sick: If someone you know and love would like to be prayed for publicly by name (and livestreamed at 8am), please email Christine at rector@stgileschurch.co.uk. Names given to Christine will be put on the Cycle of Prayer for one month.

Harvest Lunch Sunday 6 October- Ickermen will host a Harvest lunch in the Hall next Sunday 6 October 12pm-2pm. This will be a bring and share lunch - please sign up on the sheet in the centre of church and indicate either a savoury or sweet food contribution. (Hot food can be kept hot if necessary and if you can create a label with a list of ingredients for your dish, to help people with food allergies, this would be helpful.) Drinks will be provided and a small contribution to cover the cost of these will be requested on the day.

Harvest Donations for 6 October – we will once again be supporting Hillingdon Foodbank with our Harvest donations. Please bring items from the following list that the Foodbank

particularly need if possible: biscuits, cereals, condiments, treats, toiletries, tinned fish, noodles. Donations should be brought into church services on 6 October.
