How many can you find around you in the churchyard?

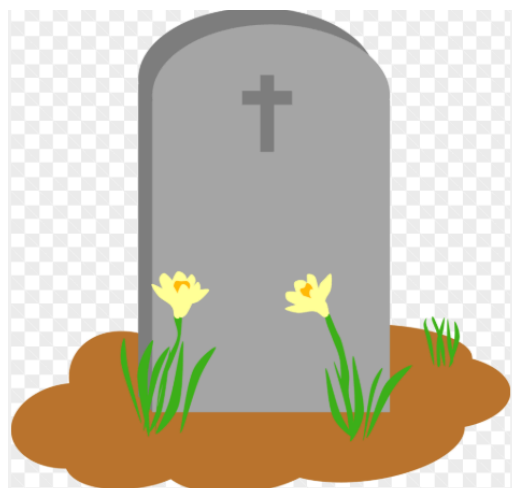
You will need to look very carefully!

know on it?

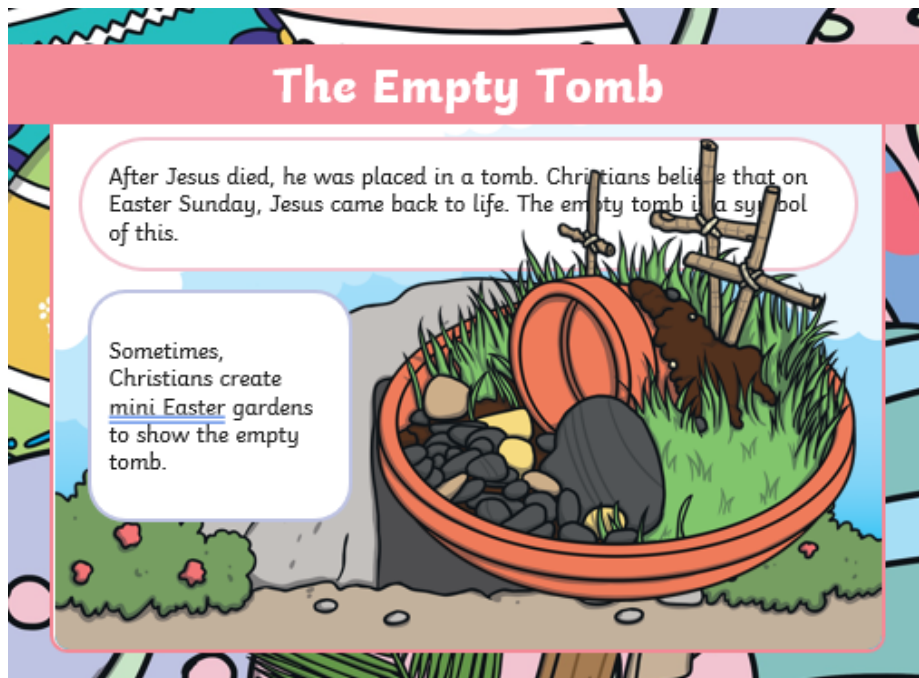
Please try to walk around the graves and
